1. **Background**

Waimarama Surf Lifesaving Club acknowledges that members of the Club are required to wear a lifeguard uniform when undertaking patrolling and Club duties. The uniform consists of

- Shorts
- Long sleeved polo top
- Wide brimmed hat

2. **Guidelines**

- The Club undertakes to provide new patrolling members with one full set of uniform clothing at a fully subsidised rate.
- Thereafter uniform will be replaced on a one for one basis as required provided that replacement is necessary due to fair wear and tear.
- Should replacement articles of clothing be required during the season for reasons other than fair wear and tear then the club will replace the item at a 50% subsidised rate.

- Uniform articles that are lost or damaged will be replaced by the responsible member at a 50% subsidised rate.
- Receipt of the uniform by members acknowledges their responsibility to wear the correct uniform at all times while representing the club during patrol hours.
